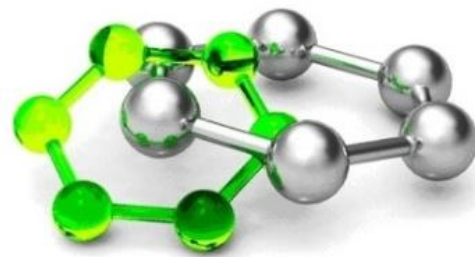


4th International Course

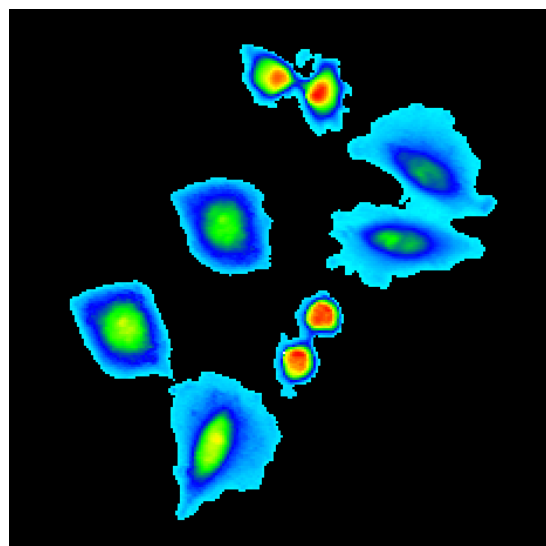
